- 100 Ste. Chapelle Riesling Champagne, Idaho 14
An attractive bouquet of fresh peaches makes this wine special
- 101 Domaine Ste. Michelle Brut Champagne, Washington 19
Tremendous value for a methode champenoise sparkler
- 102 Trevisol Prosecco del Veneto Brut, Italy 28
From Master Prosecco-maker Paolo Trevisiol comes his classic Brut made from the Prosecco grape indigenous to the Veneto region.
- 103 Sofia Blanc de Blancs, Napa (187 ml) 6
Francis Coppola created this wine for his daughter's wedding.
- 104 Domaine Chandon Riche, Napa Valley 38
An extra dry version of Chandon. Additional residual sugar creates a rich mouth feel.
- 105 Freixenet Cordon Negro Brut, Spain 18
Our best selling bubbly. A great way to start your Senang experience.
- 106 Moet Chandon White Star, France (187 ml) 27
White Star has great balance and complexity.
- 107 Veuve-Cliquot Ponsardin Yellow Label Brut, France 90
A full-bodied wine with a persistent finish. Wow!
- 108 1998 Perrier-Jouet "Fleur de Champagne", France 185
"Fleur" is a wonderful top of the line champagne. Celebrate in style!
- 109 1999 Dom Perignon Champagne 225
Seamless structure is paramount here. The finish is positively ethereal.

ITALIAN WHITE WINES

- 111 2007 Rocca Pinot Grigio 27
Rocca's Pinot Grigio, made by local icon Gianni Maccari, offers a clean slate of minerals only possible in the Colli Orientali zone of Friuli -- perhaps the best place on the planet for Pinot Grigio.
- 112 2007 Ecco Domani Pinot Grigio 19
A rounder style of wine than most Pinot Grigios yet still exhibits the crisp finish one looks for in Pinot Grigio
- 113 2007 La Quercia Bianco 26
Perfect partner to pasta, vegetables, seafood or perhaps the salad course. Only 2200 cases produced. A terrific bargain.
- 114 2007 Villa Antinori Toscana White 20
Unique blend of Trebbiano, Malvasia with a dollop of Chardonnay.
- 115 2005 Tormaresco Chardonnay 21
Crisp and dry with hints of apple and fresh pair.
- 116 2007 De Tarczal Gewurztraminer 38
Less than 600 cases produced! De Tarczal is a magical estate at the base of the Alps. Their Gewurztraminer is powerful and expressive. Stunning!
- 117 2006 Maurizio Marchetti Verdicchio Classico 28
Incredibly, this wine is all free-run juice (no pressing!), and as a Classico, is the best example in its class we have ever tried. Maurizio Marchetti's family has been making Verdicchio for generations, and it shows. Total production is less than 900 cases.
- 118 2007 Vernaccia di San Gimignano 28
This wine is a bright, exciting, floral delight with cleansing citrus and a lush body. Made by the Scotti family, this is the best Vernaccia we've come across in years. Great with flaky fish, and crisp salads.

CHARDONNAY

- 201 2006 Snake River “Unoaked” Chardonnay, Idaho 21
This unoaked chardonnay presents a leaner body style without the Buttery texture and aroma. Slightly higher in acidity, lemon notes dominate, making this an excellent wine with most light foods.
- 202 2006 Macon-Lugny “Les Charmes”, France 22
A bright, crisp rendition.
- 203 2007 Ste. Chapelle “Winemaker’s” Chardonnay, Idaho 18
While Ste. Chapelle is most famous for its Riesling, they make great Chardonnay as well.
- 204 2007 Columbia Crest “Grand Estates” Chardonnay, Washington 21
A superb Chardonnay. Typical bright, high-acid wine from the Pacific Northwest.
- 205 2006 Frei Brothers Reserve Chardonnay, Sonoma 31
Pure flavors are what you can expect from grapes coming from the coolest regions of Sonoma. The finish is wonderfully long and complex.
- 206 2007 La Crema Chardonnay, Sonoma 32
A staff favorite, La Crema has that difficult to describe focus that comes from Chardonnay grown in the cooler areas of Sonoma.
- 207 2007 Acacia Chardonnay, Napa Valley 40
Here’s a benchmark Carneros region Chardonnay exhibiting the power one is looking for from Acacia.
- 208 2008 Georges DuBouef Pouilly-Fuisse, France 40
Tightly focused with lemon and grapefruit notes.

OTHER WHITES

- 250 2007 Hogue Cellars Fume Blanc, Washington 14
Hogue Fume is a perfect aperitif wine and robust enough to stand up well to most seafood dishes.
- 251 2007 Monkey Bay “Marlborough” Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand 19
Has that lively zip one expects from NZ Sauvignon Blanc.
- 252 2007 Whitehaven Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand 37
Senang’s best selling wine!!! A benchmark Sauvignon Blanc from New Zealand. It doesn’t get much better than this!
- 253 2006 Merryvale “Starmont” Sauvignon Blanc, Napa Valley 33
Merryvale makes one of the best Sauvignon Blancs in the Valley.
- 254 2006 Ch. Ste. Michelle “Horse Heaven” Sauvignon Blanc, Washington 26
The Horse Heaven Vineyard located near Prosser produces intensely flavored fruit that creates wines of unusual power and grace.
- 255 2007 King Estate Pinot Gris, Oregon 33
One of the best Oregon Pinot Gris, this wine was aged for about 5 months “sur lie” which gives the wine its impressive complexity
- 256 2006 Ste. Chapelle Riesling, Idaho 13
Idaho has a world-wide reputation for this style of Riesling.
- 257 2007 Snake River Riesling, Idaho 16
Slightly drier and more powerful than the Ste. Chapelle.
- 258 2007 Ste. Chapelle “Special Harvest” Riesling 18
A luscious, concentrated and sweet wine.
- 259 2006 Dr. Loosen St. M Riesling, Germany 21
Dr. Loosen is one of the most respected producers of German Riesling. This one does not disappoint.

- 260 2005 Chateau de Montfort Vouvray, France 22
Vouvray is made from Chenin Blanc. This one is crisp and nearly bone-dry.
- 261 2006 Pine Ridge Chenin Blanc-Viognier, Napa Valley 26
Floral and sweet on the nose, the 2006 Chenin Blanc-Viognier exhibits fragrant aromas of pear and melon, with a delicate touch of grapefruit.
- 262 2006 Bridlewood "Reserve" Viognier, Santa Ynez 36
This wine is a powerhouse of flavor and one of the finest California Viogniers we have ever tasted.
- 263 2007 Fetzer Gewurztraminer, Mendocino 17
Spicy with just a touch of residual sugar.
- 264 2006 MacMurray Ranch Pinot Gris, Sonoma 29
A staff favorite, this wine reveals flavors of peaches and melon and has a long-lasting finish.
- 265 2004 Chateau Ste. Michelle Eroica, Washington 47
The 2004 delivers classic mineral and slate notes and lively, crisp acidity with juicy white peach aromas and flavors. Very complex.

- 300 2007 Bolla Valpolicello 15
Light, fruity wine—perfect on the deck.
- 301 2005 Frescobaldi Remole 18
Nice deep color with surprising richness.
- 302 2006 Gabbiano Chianti 17
A delightfully fresh wine with a pale ruby color and a bright, crisp finish.
- 303 2007 Tormaresca Negroamaro-Neprica, Puglia 20
Wonderful blend of Negroamaro, Primitivo and Cabernet Sauvignon.
- 304 2005 Frescobaldi Castignoli, Tuscany 26
Very nice!
- 305 2003 Antinori Peppoli Chianti Classico, Tuscany 44
The Antinoris purchased the Pèppoli Estate in 1985. A small addition of merlot smooths out the grippier sangiovese, making this an ever-reliable, top-notch Chianti.
- 306 2003 Villa Antinori Toscana Red, Italy 38
A complex, well-structured wine with smooth, stylish tannins. 60% Sangiovese, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot and 5% Syrah.
- 307 2004 Ruffino Riserva Ducale 48
A wonderfully balanced wine that delivers what you would expect from this famous producer.
- 308 2003 Tenute Marchese Antinori Chianti Classico Riserva, Tuscany 91 WS 49
One of the best Chiantis we have ever tasted! Need we say more?
- 309 2005 Terre Del Marchesato Emilio Primo, Bolgheri 49
Enologist Fabrizio Moltard displays his trademark “sweet tannins” with this wine, and achieves the smoky fruit and dusty plums seemingly achievable so effortlessly only in the Maremma. A great Super Tuscan!

ITALIAN REDS (CONTINUED)

- 310 2006 Martorana Colonna, Sicily 30
Giuseppe Martorana is one of the smallest producers of quality fine wine on the island. Less than 800 cases made.
- 311 2004 Poderi Elia Barbera d'Alba, Piedmont 34
1300 cases produced from a vineyard planted some 90 years ago. Tannins are soft. This wine pairs nicely with salmon.
- 312 2006 Eugenio Bocchino "Tom" Langhe Rosso 47
Wow! 200 cases produced. Toasted, sweet oak dominates the mouth feel but there is more than ample fruit to carry the structure.
- 313 2004 Tenuta Sette Ponti Crognolo 77
This refined, stylish blend of Sangiovese and Merlot combines fruit lushness and concentration with a palate of ripe wild cherries, black fruit, leather and vanilla repeated in the aromas. Firm, elegant tannins and integrated oak end in a balanced finish.
- 314 2003 Tenuta San Guido Guidalberto, Bolgheri 78
A supple but complex wine with 45% Merlot, 45% Cabernet Sauvignon and 10% Sangiovese. From the makers of Sassicaia.
- 315 2005 Antinori Tignanello, Toscano 110
Another triumph for Antinori, this wine, a blend of Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon, is positively sensational!
- 316 2003 Tenuta Sette Ponti Oreno, Toscano 95 WS 155
Powerful on the palate with a dense concentration of sweet fruit flavors.
- 317 1999 Ornellaia, Bolgheri 94 WS 210
Ornellaia is a Bordeaux-inspired blend consisting principally of Cabernet, Cabernet Franc, and Merlot. In 2003 a small percentage of Petit Verdot was introduced.

- 320 2006 Ravenswood Cabernet Sauvignon, California 19
Ravenswood's motto—"no wimpy wines"
- 321 2006 Louis M. Martini "Sonoma" Cabernet Sauvignon 30
A nice little cab for the money.
- 322 2004 Kendall-Jackson Meritage, California 26
65% Cabernet Sauvignon, 34% Merlot and 1% Cabernet Franc.
- 323 2006 Francis Coppola Claret, Sonoma 35
Francis Ford Coppola makes sublime films and superb wines. Claret is a Bordeaux-style blend yet has tremendous fruit and a complex finish.
- 324 2005 Rodney Strong Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma 30
Well balanced with loads of fruit and a polished finish.
- 325 2003 Chateau Greysac, Cru Bourgeois Bordeaux, France 35
Our favorite petit chateaux.
- 326 2005 Frei Brothers Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma 39
We've never tasted a Frei Brothers wine we didn't like.
- 327 2005 Sterling Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley 47
Cedar-like nose followed by a good burst of fruit and a lingering finish.
- 328 2005 Franciscan Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley 42
We really like this wine—what a great price for a Napa Valley Cab.
- 329 2004 William Hill Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley 77
Loads of upfront fruit and polished, sweet oak create this wonderful Cabernet
- 330 2005 Pine Ridge "Rutherford" Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley 85
Pine Ridge is, without question, one of our favorite Napa Valley Wineries. It seems their wines are climbing to greater heights with each vintage.

- 331 2004 Chateau St. Jean Cinq Cepages, Sonoma 110
An elegantly-styled wine created from the five Bordeaux blending varieties: Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Petit Verdot and Malbec. Trust us, this is really good!!
- 332 2000 Chateau Figeac, Premier Grand Cru Classe St. Emilion 93 WS 150
A surprisingly full bodied Figeac, one of the real winners from the amazing 2000 vintage in Bordeaux.
- 333 1999 Opus One, Napa Valley 93 WS 230
Much like its French cousin, Chateau Mouton-Rothschild, Opus has a warm, cedary, saddle leather-like nose with loads of smooth fruit character. This wine is now fully mature and drinking well.
- 334 2002 Joseph Phelps Insignia 96 WS 290
Dense purple color, seamless character. A blend of 78% Cabernet Sauvignon, 14% Merlot, 7% Petit Verdot, and 1% Malbec. Only 3 bottles left!

MERLOT

- 400 2006 Ravenswood Merlot, Sonoma 20
Good dark color, sweet oak on the palate. Very nice.
- 401 2005 Columbia Crest "Grand Estate" Merlot, Washington 22
Has that great black cherry flavor that is unique to Washington state Merlot.
- 402 2004 Jacuzzi Rosso di Sette Fratelli Merlot, Sonoma 26
Blended with just a touch of Syrah, this wine has wonderful structure and harmony.
- 403 2005 Clos du Bois Merlot, Sonoma 32
Violet-like tones in the nose with good color and a nice finish.
- 404 2004 Canoe Ridge Merlot, Washington 32
Good concentration of flavor. A very special Merlot.

- 500 2005 Lindemans Bin 75 Riesling 14
A bone-dry Riesling with lots of bright fruit flavors.
- 501 2006 Rosemount Traminer-Riesling 19
Lovely floral nose, off dry with an elegant spicy finish.
- 502 2006 Wolf-Blass Chardonnay 21
Wonderful tropical fruit flavor. This is the number one selling wine in Canada
- 503 2005 Greg Norman Cabernet-Merlot, Limestone Coast 30
Greg Norman Cabernet-Merlot—A great value.
- 504 2005 Penfolds Bin 128 Coonawarra Shiraz 44
Fabulous concentration of flavor with a lengthy finish.
- 505 2006 Annie's Lane Cabernet-Merlot, Clare Valley 34
A smoothly textured, fine red wine.
- 506 2005 Rosemount Show Reserve Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon 44
A huge wine with tightly-wound tannins and plenty of fruit for the long haul.
- 507 2005 Penfolds Bin 28 Kalima Shiraz 44
Bin 28 is an elegant wine with superb length on the finish.
- 508 2006 Two Hands 'Gnarly Dudes' Shiraz, Barossa Valley 56
An impressive, powerful wine with intense blackberry and cedar aromas.
- 509 2003 The Gate "Davey Family Vineyards" Shiraz, McLaren Vale 75
Deep purple color, dense black fruit flavor. Superb
- 510 2001 Penfolds RWT Shiraz, Barossa Valley 94 WS 122
Perfectly balanced with dark berry fruits framed by spicy French Oak.

OTHER REDS

- 620 2006 Sebeca Cabernet-Pinotage, South Africa 15
The initial impression is of Cabernet, but the wine exhibits smoky-like flavors that come from South Africa's signature grape Pinotage.
- 621 2004 Sawtooth Syrah, Idaho 27
Exciting blend of 86% Syrah, 7% Cinsault, 7% Mourvedre and 1% Grenache.
Aromas of plum, raspberry, strawberry and creamy spices proceed rich fruit flavors with round, supple tannins and long finish.
- 622 2004 Ste. Michelle Syrah, Washington 22
Soft, lush, jam-like on the palate.
- 623 2007 Fat Bastard Shiraz, France 21
Ripe and bright, this is a delicious wine.
- 624 2005 Ravenswood Shiraz, Sonoma 20
Soft and appealing with blackberry flavors.
- 625 2005 Charles Back Goats du Roam Red, South Africa 23
Juicy-ripe, fresh fruit flavors.
- 626 2007 Terrazas Malbec, Argentina 23
Malbec from Argentina is becoming very popular—this is a good one.
- 627 2006 Cline "Ancient Vines" Mourvedre, Sonoma 27
Wow! Deep purple color, full-bodied flavor.
- 628 2006 Cline "Ancient Vines" Carignane, Sonoma 27
These guys know how to make wine!
- 629 2006 Cline "Cool Climate" Syrah, Sonoma 27
An interesting take on the Syrah grape. Normally grown in the warmest wine growing regions, Cline has wrought a very elegant, yet powerful wine that seems to grow with every sip.

- 630 2006 Francis Coppola Syrah-Shiraz, Sonoma 32
Very deeply colored with jam-like flavors and a lingering aftertaste.
- 631 2006 Ferrari-Carano Siena, Sonoma 47
An absolutely beautiful wine. Siena is a blend of 84% Sangiovese and small amounts of Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot and Malbec.
- 632 2006 Terrazas Malbec Reserva, Argentina 35
A deep, intense wine with tremendous power.
- 633 2003 Frei Brothers "Reserve" Syrah, Sonoma 41
A superb wine—spicy, sweet fruit with a peppery sort of finish.
- 634 2003 Domaine Roquette Chateauneuf du Pape, France 54
A blockbuster wine, deep purple in color with incredible focus on the palate
- 635 2002 Marques de Arienzo Crianza, Rioja 25
This expressive wine is fruit forward with lots of jammy flavors.
- 636 2006 Red Guitar 'Old Vines' Tempranillo-Garnacha 21
The wine exhibits an intense garnet red color. In the mouth, the fruit is well balanced by subtle acidity and tannins followed by a smooth finish.
- 637 1994 Marques de Arienzo Gran Reserva, Rioja 48
Gran Reserva is made only in exceptional vintages. A classic aged Rioja with spicy notes and a velvety texture.
- 638 2006 Cline Zinfandel, Sonoma 30
Cline Sonoma is highly allocated. We were very fortunate to get a case.
- 639 2006 Cline "Ancient Vines" Zinfandel 27
Dark purple color, exquisite jammy flavors, very powerful finish.
- 640 2006 Rodney Strong "Knotty Vines" Zinfandel, Sonoma 18
Created from 40 year old Sonoma vines.

PINOT NOIR & BURGUNDY

- 900 2006 Georges Duboeuf Beaujolais-Villages, France 22
This lovely wine has excellent depth, structure, and balance. Superb!
- 901 2007 Mirassou Pinot Noir, California 18
An elegant wine with strawberry flavors.
- 902 2006 Indian Creek Pinot Noir, Idaho 27
Yes, a Pinot Noir is grown in Idaho and this is a nice one.
- 903 2007 Estancia Pinot Noir, California 27
Pleasant and soft-textured, with cherry and berry spicy notes that linger.
- 904 2006 Erath Pinot Noir, Oregon 35
Another staff favorite
- 905 2005 MacMurray Ranch Pinot Noir, Sonoma 36
This wine reveals toasty oak intermixed with plum and black cherries.
- 906 2006 Acacia Carneros Pinot Noir, Napa Valley 40
This wonderful wine is creamy-textured and full of flavor.
- 907 2006 King Estate Pinot Noir, Oregon 47
A bright and inviting wine with a warm texture and loads of black cherry fruit.
- 908 2005 Whitehaven Pinot Noir, New Zealand 46
An elegant wine that displays complex black cherry fruit.
- 909 2006 Rex Hill Pinot Noir, Oregon 47
Lite, supple and generous with its spicy plum and earth flavors, finishing with silky tannins and a distinct touch of coffee and caramel flavors. Superb!
- 910 2006 Archery Summit "Premier Cuvee" Pinot Noir, Oregon 78
This full-bodied, fruit-packed wine is intense and immensely flavorful.
- 911 2005 Archery Summit "Renegade Ridge Estate" Pinot Noir 170
The best Pinot Noir in the house. Just 5 bottles available.

- 700 2007 Beringer White Zinfandel-Chardonnay, Napa Valley 16
A dollop of Chardonnay in the blend creates a wine with superb structure.
- 701 2006 De Loach White Zinfandel, Sonoma 18
This is seriously one of the best White Zinfandels we've tasted.
- 702 2006 Charles Back Goats do Roam Rosé, South Africa 22
Not overly sweet – just delicious.
- 703 2006 Chateau Ste. Michelle "Nellie's Garden" Dry Rose, Washington 19
Created from Syrah grapes, this wine is bone dry.

DESSERT WINES

- 990 2006 Ste. Chapelle Riesling Ice Wine, Idaho 36
Idaho provides the perfect conditions for superb ice wine: sufficient warmth to ripen the grapes and cold enough weather right after harvest to freeze them on the vine.
- 991 2005 Banfi Florus Moscadello di Montalcino, Italy 36
Color is rich and golden with a flowery and exotic bouquet. The taste is sweet, full and warm with hints of honey, raisins and exotic fruits.
- 992 2001 Taylor Fladgate LBV Port, Oporto 38
Taylor Fladgate is one of the most respected Port houses.
- 993 Penfolds Grandfather Port, Australia 89
A fine old liqueur tawny from Australia.
- 994 Fonseca Bin 27 Port, Oporto 33
Powerful fruit flavor one normally gets only in true vintage port.
- 995 Sandeman Cream Sherry, Spain 19
Typical nutty flavor.
- 996 Blandys Malmsey Madeira, Madeira Islands of Portugal 39
Malmsey Madeira is made from the Malvasia grape. Unique!
